

How we get water! (Ages 5-10)



Have you ever wondered where your water comes from?
It doesn't just come out of the tap!

Match the different ways of delivering water to families to the drawing:



Aqueduct

This is an outdoor tap that provides water to a small community. People in the community bring water jugs and fill them, then carry the water to their house



Well

This pipe or channel carries fresh water to people



Borehole and Electric Pump

These are underground pipes that connect to a central water source. The water is piped right into people's houses and comes out of taps or in the toilet



Standpost

This is a hole in the ground dug until it hits water. People get water by dipping their pail into it



House Connection

This is a very, very deep well. It uses electricity to pump water to the surface
